1. What do you know?

What are you 100% sure about, the facts.

2. What do you think you know?

Which assumptions do you have?

3. What do you want to know?

What are your research goals?



Avoid closed questions (yes or no)

E.g. Do you understand what you see? Instead: To what extent do you understand everything you see?

Don't answer the user's questions yourself but keep asking them back

E.g. user asks: "I don't uderstand this, what does this mean?" answer with: "What do you think this could mean?"

Avoid suggestive questions

'Would you agree that the onboarding went easily and was clear? Or not?' <u>Instead</u>: 'How do you evaluate the onboarding?'

Be curious

Ask a lot of 'why?' questions.
